

**Bethany Brand** earned her Ph.D. in Clinical/Community Psychology at the University of Maryland, College Park in 1993. She became interested in trauma in graduate school, which led to her completing her master's thesis with Frank Putnam, M.D. and her dissertation with Pamela Alexander, Ph.D. She completed her internship at George Washington University then took a two year postdoctoral fellowship specializing in trauma related disorders at Sheppard Pratt Health System, after which she continued as an attending and supervising psychologist for four years. In 1998, she accepted a professorship at Towson University where she continues to work as an Associate Professor in the Psychology Department. Dr. Brand has won several teaching awards including the Maryland Psychology Teacher of the Year. She has written numerous articles and book chapters on topics related to trauma. Her research focuses on assessing and treating trauma disorders. Dr. Brand is currently the primary investigator on a prospective, longitudinal international treatment outcome study of dissociative disorders. She supervises postdoctoral fellows in psychological assessment at Sheppard Pratt Health System and has a private practice in Towson, Maryland.
